PROBLEM: NEEDS ADD'L THERAPY

A patient with coronary artery disease had a history of quadruple bypass (coronary artery bypass graft) and a heart attack a year before. At the time of the consult, the patient reported that their LDL cholesterol was 242 mg/dl, which is much higher than their goal and extremely concerning based upon their cardiovascular history. The patient was not taking a statin type cholesterol medication and the patient claimed their cardiologist was aware that they were not taking a statin. The Tria Pharmacist was concerned there may be some confusion regarding this issue and contacted the cardiologist office who claimed they were not aware and were under the impression he was taking atorvastatin. They agreed to schedule a follow up appointment to review lab work and initiate statin therapy.

OUTCOMES

Upon follow up, the patient reported they were taking the appropriate medications and were feeling much better.
