PROBLEM: UNSAFE DRUG

A 48-year old patient with pre-diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, allergies and heartburn had an appointment with Tria Health. The patient was taking Esomeprazole two times a day for heartburn. Due to increased safety concerns regarding medications such as esomeprazole, the Tria Health pharmacist recommended replacing their current medication with an over-the-counter ranitidine. The patient and physician agreed. Upon follow-up, the patient had stopped esomeprazole and the replacement ranitidine was working well for the heartburn symptoms.
